Apply at the rate: 12.0 - 15.5 fl. oz. product/acre

### **Application Instructions:**

**Atticus Acadia™ 2 SC** applications must begin prior to disease development and continue throughout the year on 7-to-12-day intervals following the resistance management guidelines. Under conditions that favor severe disease epidemics, the higher application rates must be used. Applications may be made by ground, air or chemigation. An adjuvant may be added at specified rates. A horticultural spray oil must be used to improve control of greasy spot.

Do not apply more than two sequential applications of **Atticus Acadia™ 2 SC** or other Group 11 fungicides before alternation with a fungicide that is not in Group 11.

Do not make more than four (4) applications of **Atticus Acadia™ 2 SC** or other Group 11 fungicide per year.
